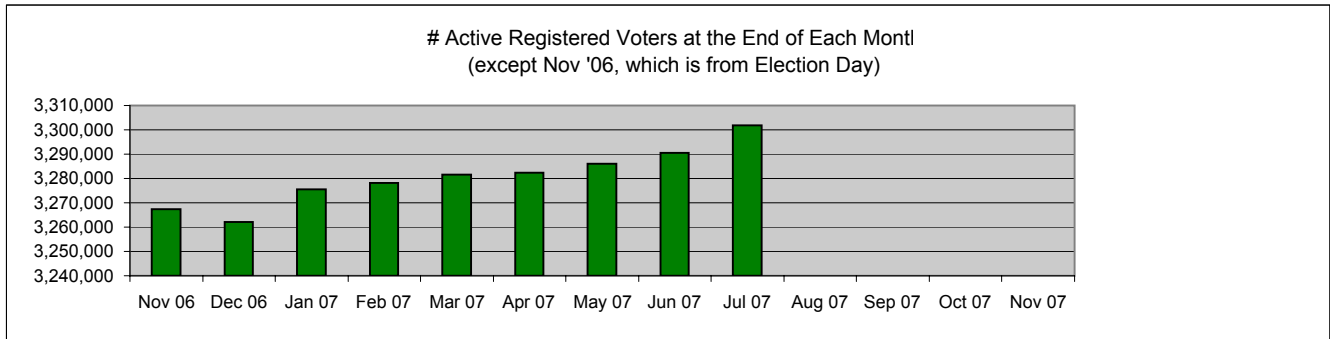




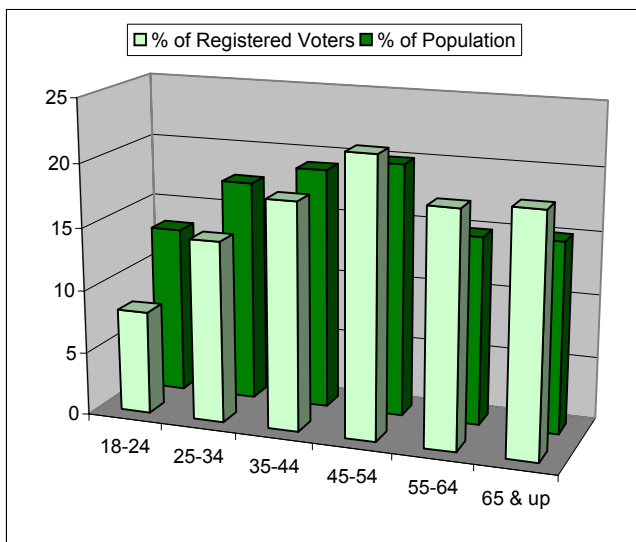

**VOTER REGISTRATION REPORT - July 27, 2007**

**Executive Summary.** We have 3,301,802 active registered voters (previous high was 3,514,078 in Nov '04). The percentage of eligible citizens that are actively registered to vote rose by .3% since last month's report. The voter registration rolls increased in all but 7 counties. The age distribution of our registered voters did not change significantly from last month's report.

**Estimate of the statewide percentage of eligible citizens that are actively registered to vote: 73.3%.**
